The professional advice we have received is to fix the screen at the end of the Community Centre hall, opposite the stage. Basically, it will be where the screen is normally erected now.

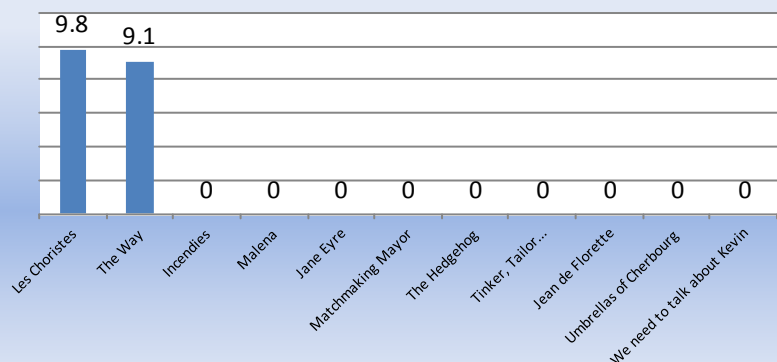
The club is grateful for the help and support shown by the management at the Community Centre in this venture.
