We've made some headway in encouraging those of you who shop on the Internet, to use Amazon through the link on our website. Thank you to those using it because every time you make a purchase, so the club receives a small commission at no extra cost to you. This helps with our funds.

Now I'd like to encourage you to take a closer look at Facebook, the social networking site. Facebook has the capacity to reach literally millions of people at the press of a key. It also allows members to interact with similar minded folk. You can set your own 'profile' to limit who can make contact with you through the links.

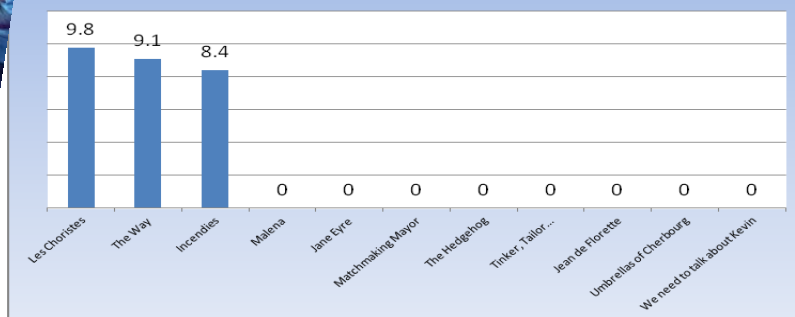
