Launching on Monday 1 November 2010, the site will still bring you all the information you need about the club but there will now be facilities for members to participate much more.

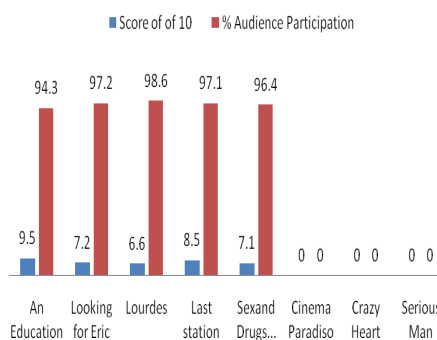

2011 Prices

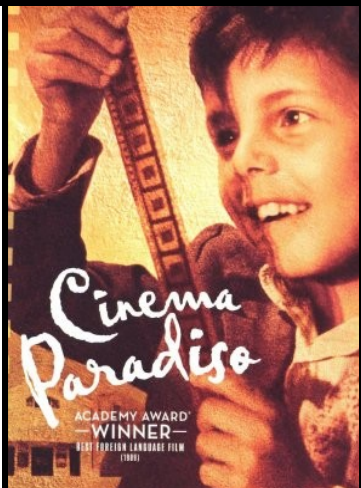

Cinema Paradiso (Cert.PG)

Saturday 6 November 2010

Seen as an example of "nostalgic postmodernism", this film intertwines sentimentality with comedy and nostalgia with pragmatism. It explores issues of youth, coming of age and reflections (in adulthood) about the past. The imagery in each scene can be said to reflect Toto's (the central character) idealised memories about his childhood. Cinema Paradiso is also a celebration of films; as a projectionist, young Toto develops the passion for films that shapes his life path in adulthood.
